

CHF Research & Insight

Congenital heart disease (CHD) is one of the most prevalent birth defects worldwide, impacting approximately 1 in every 100 live births. It encompasses a wide range of conditions, from mild defects to more complex conditions that demand surgical correction or lifelong medical management. The most common CHD in children includes Atrial Septal Defect (ASD), Ventricular Septal Defect (VSD), Tetralogy of Fallot, and Coarctation of the Aorta. The root cause behind these conditions are largely unknown, but conditions like Down Syndrome, family history of heart disease, diabetes, obesity, viral infections during pregnancy etc. can affect fetal development. If detected early, it can have a positive outcome for children born with CHD.



CHD also poses a significant threat to pregnant women having heart disease. It can escalate the risk of heart failure, high BP, arrhythmias and preterm birth putting both the mother and the baby at risk. As a result, proper preconception counselling is required. Collaborations to be made with the cardiologists to provide best care plans on specific heart conditions so as to ensure optimal management on overall maternal health.



PROGRAMME HIGHLIGHTS:

CHF & Gail Gas takes Initiative



On February 18th, the Childheart Foundation, in partnership with GAIL Gas, held a successful medical camp in Meerut Shahjahanpur, where 220 children were screened for health issues. During the screening, 10 children were found to have suspected congenital heart defects and have since received treatment.

This camp highlights the Child heart Foundation's dedication to providing vital healthcare to children in underserved areas, with support from GAIL Gas. The collaboration helped ensure that these children received the care they needed for a healthier future.

Medical Camp Supported by NTPC



On March 27th, the Childheart Foundation, in collaboration with NTPC, held a medical camp in Payavali Gaon,

Dadri, screening over 188 children for congenital heart defects (CHD). An awareness session was also conducted to educate the community on CHD prevention.



Awareness Program

On March 26th, the Child heart Foundation, in collaboration with Concentrix, held an awareness session at the UPHC Gandhi Nagar Dispensary in Gurgaon. The session was attended by 33 ASHA workers, ANMs, and Anganwadi staff, focusing on the early detection and prevention of congenital heart defects (CHD) in children. This initiative aimed to empower local healthcare workers with the knowledge to identify CHD signs and provide timely medical support.



COMMUNITY AWARENESS PROGRAM

On 18th Feb awareness session was held for 38 ASHA workers and Anganwadi staff, focusing on the importance of early detection and prevention of congenital heart defects. This session aimed to empower local health workers with the knowledge to identify signs of CHD in children and ensure timely medical intervention.

This initiative, supported by GAIL Gas, highlights the importance of both medical care and community education in improving children's health.

► PROGRAMME HIGHLIGHTS:



CHF and Concentrix Medical Camp in Rohini

The Childheart Foundation, in collaboration with Concentrix, organized a medical camp on Pocket 5, Rohini, Delhi. A total of 181 children were screened, and 2 children were suspected of having congenital heart defects (CHD) and are receiving further treatment. This initiative helped ensure that children in the community received vital health screenings and support.

Medical Camp in Delhi Slum Areas with ABB



On March 26th, the Childheart Foundation, in collaboration with ABB, organized a medical camp in Jahangirpuri, New Delhi.

A total of **128 children** were screened, and one child was suspected of having congenital heart defects (CHD) and received prompt treatment.



Medical Camp in Slums

On February 1, 2025, the Childheart Foundation, in collaboration with ABB, held a successful medical camp in Delhi. A total of 200 children were screened, and 6 children were suspected of having congenital heart defects (CHD) and are receiving further treatment. This camp provided crucial health screenings and support to local children.



AWARENESS SESSION IN SULTANPURI WITH MANKIND DISTRICT LEVEL

On March 22nd, an awareness session was held at the district level in Sultanpuri, where **over 86 ASHA workers, ANMs, and Anganwadi staff participated**. The session, in collaboration with Mankind, focused on raising awareness about congenital heart defects (CHD) and empowering local healthcare workers to identify and prevent CHD in children.



Medical and Awareness Session in Meerut Slum Areas

On February 1st, a medical and awareness session was held in the slum areas of Meerut, where over 189 children were screened for health issues. Two children were suspected of having congenital heart defects (CHD) and are receiving further treatment. ASHA workers and Anganwadi staff also participated in the session, learning about the symptoms of CHD and how to identify them early for timely intervention.
