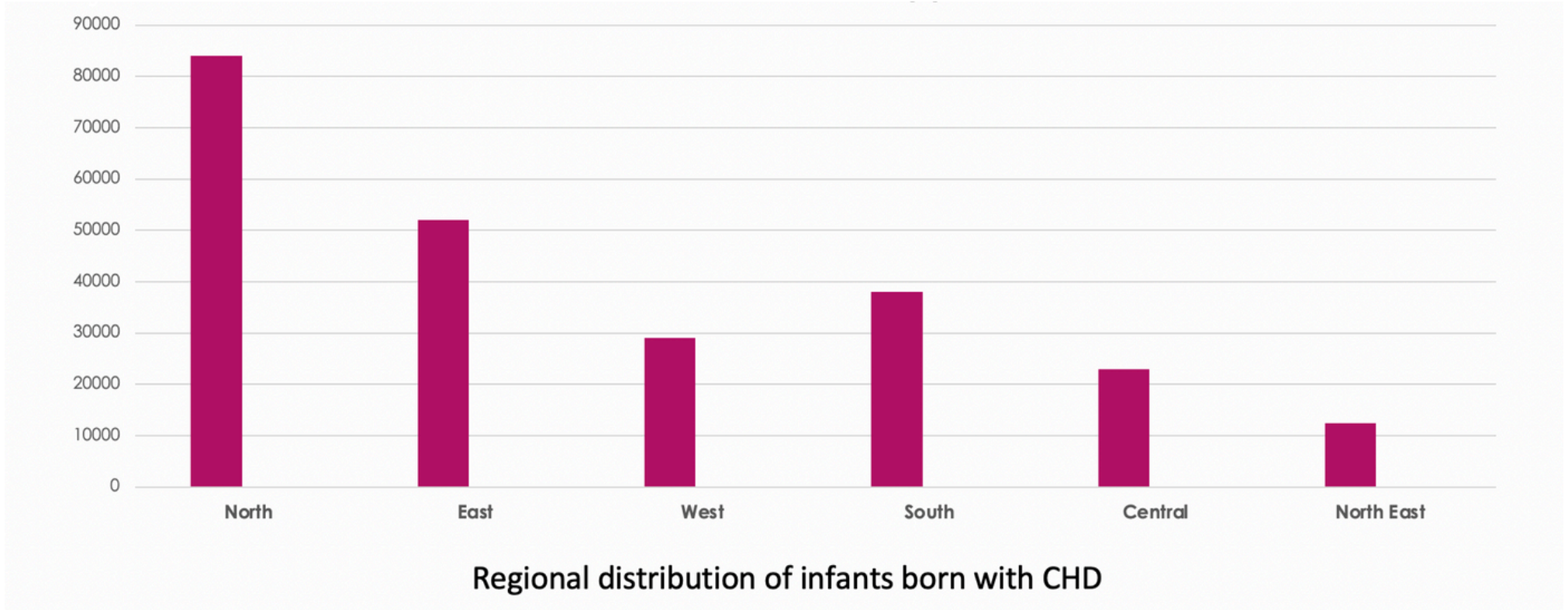

CONGENITAL HEART DISEASE LOAD DISTRIBUTION IN INDIA

- The prevalence of CHD cases in Infants is much higher in the Northern and Eastern parts of India.
- The total number of cases born with critical CHD in India is higher in North and East India and merely 17% of total cases in North India and 11.8% cases in East India are operated at < 1 year of age.

GAPS IN HEALTHCARE

- Some of the most significant achievements that India has made in recent years in public health space have been the ongoing work to establish 24 AIIMS (All India Institute of Medical Sciences) across the country (19 AIIMS already established as of January 2022), as well as the roll-out of several programs under the National Health Mission (NHM).
- However, the demand continues to rise and as a result, India faces an increasing gap in the availability of healthcare centres as well as healthcare professionals. Even without the added burden of COVID-19 cases, India was already bearing the highest global burden of hypertension, diabetes, and cancer.
- The Rural Health Statistics 2020-21, released by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare depicts that almost two-thirds of the country's population resides in rural areas and yet only 33 per cent of the total health workers and 27 per cent of doctors are available. They also lack opportunities and means to seek expert care. The main impediment to the delivery of
- Qualitative and equitable healthcare is the paucity of healthcare providers across primary, secondary, and tertiary levels

CHF SAHYOG

- It started with one follow-up call to Piyush, a PH life care patient in the remote village of Bihar, which prompted us to develop this program. Our team had been calling Piyush's parents for follow-up visits for us to send him medicines.
- Piyush has been registered under the PH Life Care program since 2020 and is getting monthly free medicines for his life-threatening heart disease called Pulmonary Hypertension. He had not come for his required check-up for 8 months and every time we called, the parents assured us of their visit. We sensed the desperation in their voice and we asked them the reason for the delay, We were shocked to know that the delay in follow-up was due to their financial condition as they could not afford the travel to Delhi. We assured them financial help for travel, food and stay. Thus, through CHF SAYHOG, we help single moms, with travel expenses, food, out-of-station stay in Delhi, medicines, and pre-admission medical tests for patients who are very poor.

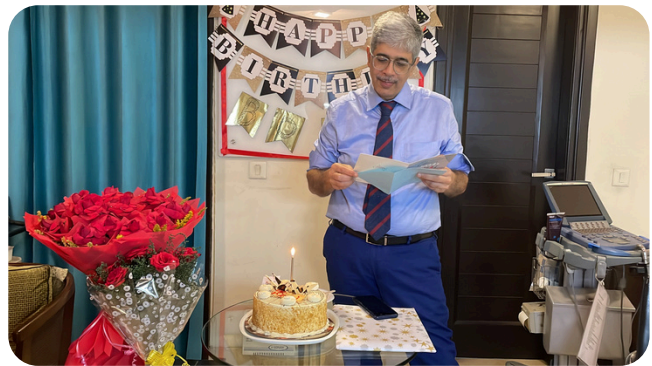

In the midst of anticipation, Ashutosh and Mamta learned their unborn baby might have an underdeveloped heart chamber. Hope led them to Dr. Vikas Kohli of the Child Heart Foundation after they found him on YouTube. A **fetal echocardiogram** unveiled a challenge - the baby's heart lacked a vital wall, a condition needing immediate attention.

"Aahil's Triumph: A Journey of Healing and Hope"



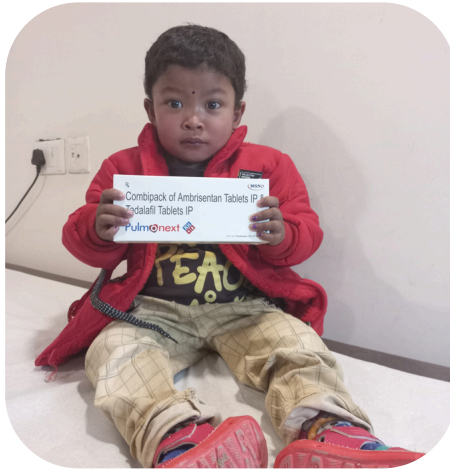
