"Post Covid, there are a lot of families coming for help. We need more participation from the community for helping them".

We increased the help being offered to children with CHD during COVID times. This may be surprising but true. Two waves of COVID hadn't stopped us from working for children with Congenital Heart Defects. We did successful surgeries on 52 children.

We are screening more children and pregnant women to detect Cardiac Abnormalities during the Fetal Stage. We have restarted our OPD service in Siliguri & Punjab. We are on the outlook of increasing our presence in different states. We are not focusing only on CHD, even expanded to Pulmonary Hypertension treatment. As a result, we have 15 PH patients registered for Free PH Medicine.

Our human resources have grown. We are a team of 9 members and looking forward to growing with immense impact. As we closed our 9th year, we have done a total of surgeries on 140+ children. And we look forward to increasing our volume by increasing our budgets and tying up with different hospitals to help lower the waiting period.

Under our CHF Hridaya Saksham, we have tied up with the Delhi Government to donate Echocardiography Machines and train at least two doctors per government hospital to help achieve self-sustainable and accommodative Pediatric Cardiology. As a start, we have donated three Echocardiography machines to 3 different government hospitals and as planned doctors' training will kick start soon. Not only will it help increase the accessibility to Pediatric Cardiac Treatment, but it will also help us save many lives.

Finally, we have digitized our data with the help of Green Rope & Excel.

Last but not least, I want to thank all our CSR partners, Individual Donors, the Delhi government, and Government hospitals for trusting us with the responsibilities. Above all, fighting CHD from every angle makes us a trustworthy and impactful team.

We want your association with us to increase so more children benefit from the surgeries.

CHF has come a long way in the past 9 years. Our core area of work is the screening and treatment of children with heart diseases. We achieve this through community mobilization, Government hospital outreach, and awareness for children from economically weaker sections of society.

Our area of work is very specialized and high-end. Pediatric Cardiology has very recently been taken as a priority by the Government because Congenital Heart Diseases are one of the major birth defects. We lose children every day due to lack of awareness, lack of accessible medical help and lack of funds for treatment. 2021 has proven to be a tough but rewarding year for CHF.

Our community outreach during Covid 19 second wave with support for medicines, hospitalization, and groceries was a challenging but gratifying task for our team. Our efforts in supporting the Delhi Government during the crisis have been duly appreciated by them.

Getting 56 children treated in a span of 8-9 months after elective surgeries started in hospitals is the biggest joy of last financial year.

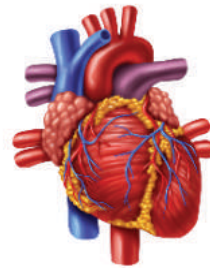

# WHY CONGENITAL HEART DEFECTS?

- **Congenital Heart Diseases (CHD) are one of the most common birth defects. The disease burden is more in developing countries because of the high birth rate and inadequate health infrastructure.**
- **Due to the high treatment cost and a long waiting list in Government Hospitals, many children have lost their lives.**
- **Lack of awareness of CHD or Child heart disease many parents has lost their children without even knowing the diagnosis or reasons.**



## FACTS ABOUT CHD

- a. 1 in every 100 newborns has heart disease
- b. Every year, there are more than 1,80,000 to 2,00,000 children born with one or more types of CHD
- c. Only 15,000 get operated on, the rest don't survive or are added to the pool of waitlisted patients.
- d. Most congenital heart patients require treatment in the first year of their life, poor parents find it impossible to raise funds for treatment which can run into lakhs. They end up losing their children.



## CHALLENGES

- a. Heart surgeries, and treatment procedures are very expensive, underprivileged parents are unable to afford
- b. Health insurance doesn't cover it because CHD is considered a pre-existing disease
- c. Doctors and nurses qualified in pediatric cardiology are very few
- d. The infrastructure needed for pediatric cardiology is geographically limited in India
- e. Lack of awareness regarding the disease
- f. The waiting period at Government hospitals is too long as the patient load is too high.



## HOW TO DEAL WITH THIS?

## 1. PRADAAN - 2500+

We offer free/discounted screening in Delhi, Siliguri and Jalandhar to children (0 to 18 years) from underprivileged families to diagnose any type of congenital heart disease (CHD). Counselling for disease management, nutritional importance and further support for treatment is also provided under the program.

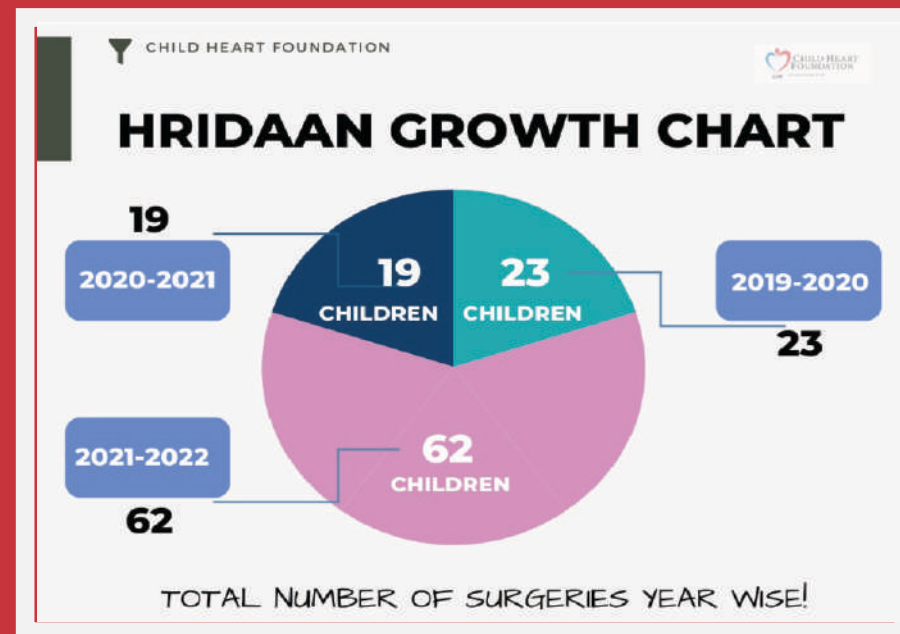
## 2. HRIDAAN - 57 Surgeries

Patients who get diagnosed with any type of CHD and whose parents/ family are unable to fund the treatments are registered under this program. The registration process involves due diligence based on the

- a. Submission of address proof.
- b. Income certificate
- c. Identity of the parent/guardian to be certified by the local government authorizing authority.

The parents/caregivers of the patients are also counselled about the fundraising and the treatment process. Hand holding is provided to the family during the pre, during and post the treatment of the child.

**During 2021-22, Out of the total screenings done, 57 children were diagnosed with CHD and underwent successful operations.**





# 3. JEVANSH - 355 Beneficiaries

We offer Fetal Echocardiography services free of cost to pregnant women for finding any cardiac abnormality in the fetus. These cases are referred to CHF from Govt hospital  
In 2021-22, 355 pregnant women underwent Fetal Echocardiography Screening.





## 4. SUGYAN - 2000 Beneficiaries

Covid-19 affected our community outreach by not physically holding any events, workshops and field visits. During 2020-21, we used our digital platforms to spread awareness about COVID 19(Precautions and Guidelines), Congenital Heart Defects and Pulmonary Hypertension.

After going through 2 COVID waves, our SUGYAAN team immediately started its awareness campaign and also trained Health Care Workers to identify signs & symptoms of CHD and to spread the importance of Fetal Echocardiography as an early step in detecting Cardiac Abnormalities in the Fetal stage.  
More than 500- Health Care Workers

# 5. PH LIFE CARE - 18 Beneficiaries

As PH Medicines is very expensive, CHF provides free Medicine for children with Pulmonary Hypertension belonging to underprivileged families. CHF provided Free Echocardiography screening and diagnosis to 215 children with Pulmonary Arterial Hypertension (PAH) . Supporting 18 children from different states of India through courier service.





## 6. CHF SAHYOG

The second wave of COVID 19, has highly impacted the health infrastructure of the nation leaving many to suffer at their cost. The lower-income groups have found it extremely challenging to cope with the virus. Within all the suffering, something has risen above all the chaos that is humanity. It is very humble and touching to see how in such times each individual has come forward to do their part. One such brave soul is- Parissa Sikand

Community health being the core focus of Child Heart Foundation, we joined hands with Parissa Sikand and founded 'CHF-PARISSA SIKAND COVID RELIEF FUND' It was an endeavour taken up so bravely by a 12-year-old girl to help children and families struggling for medicines, groceries, books, and hospitalization. She raised 12 lakhs and we collectively helped needy mothers, children and families belonging to lower-income groups.

Under this fund, we also helped cases referred to us from DCPCR who got calls on the government child helpline number.

This fund helped us reach people in Pan India who needed help with COVID treatments which include expenses for medicines, tests and other hospitalization charges.

Ration supplies for families who have lost earning member  
School and books expenses for families who can't afford due to loss of job or earning member.

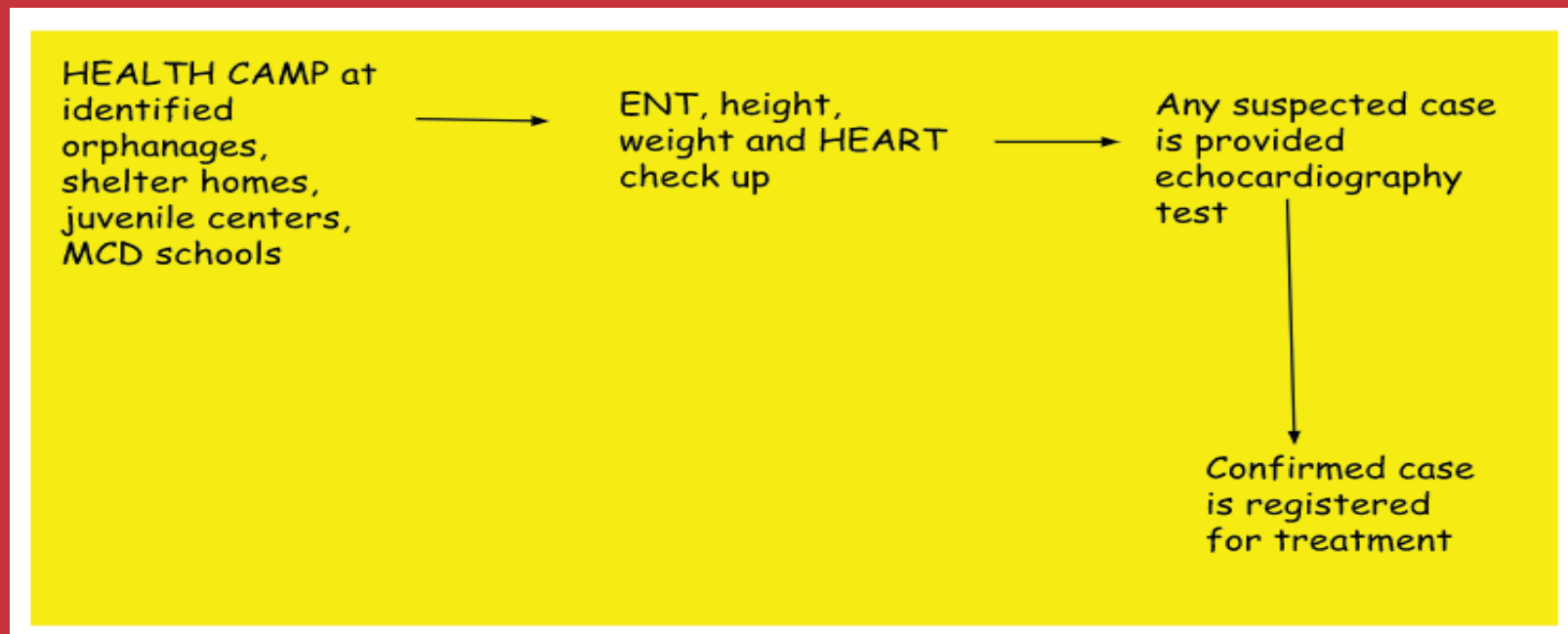
Also helped non covid cases involving needy mothers and children.



# 7. PRADAAN OUTREACH PROGRAM

Providing screenings services for any suspected heart disease in children referred to us was already going on for 9 years. Through this program, we wanted to extend our services to children from the most vulnerable backgrounds who can't access specialized medical help.

Our objective through this program is to screen children from orphanages, shelter homes, and juvenile detention centres as these children have no past medical records and family history so it becomes very important to offer them basic health camps for ENT, weight, height and a special focus on cardiac evaluation. Any suspected case is referred for echocardiography screening at our centre through PraDAAN and any confirmed case is registered in CHF HRIDAAN and offered free treatment. We are planning to collaborate with the Department of Women and Child Welfare for this program in 2022-23



CHF conducted 1st health camp on December 24, 2021.

A total number of 119 children were screened for

Cardiac Abnormalities and three of them were diagnosed with CHD .

## 8. HRIDYA SAKSHAM - CHF EDUCATION

At present, we have only 260 pediatric cardiologists in India. In order to bridge the gap, CHF initiated this program to train Pediatricians and Radiologists. We have been able to train 150 doctors under this program. Under our primary survey, we found that Delhi has 35 hospitals with pediatric departments, 23 have NICUs but only 3 had echocardiography machines so we proposed to get echo machines donated to different Govt. hospitals.

*Under RITES LTD CSR PROJECT, we have successfully installed 3 echocardiography machines in a) Bhagwan Mahavir Hospital b) Lal Bahadur Hospital under Delhi Government and c) Kasturba Hospital under the Municipal Corporation of Delhi.*

We will also train 2 doctors from each hospital over a period of one year to make the hospital self-sustainable in pediatric cardiology diagnosis. A similar project model is planned with the IRFC CSR project with 3 other Government hospitals

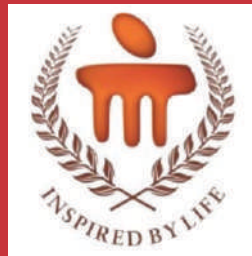

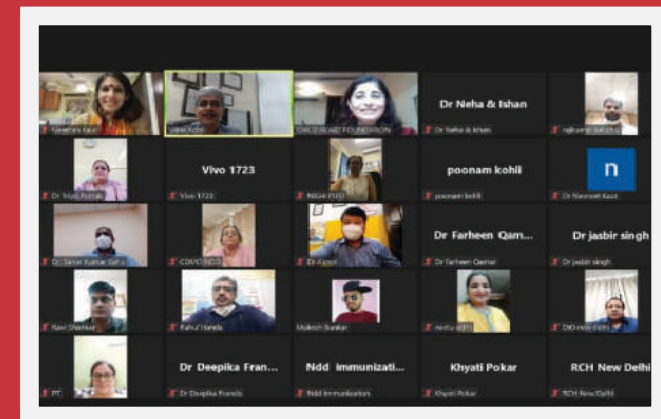


# WORLD HEART DAY CELEBRATION

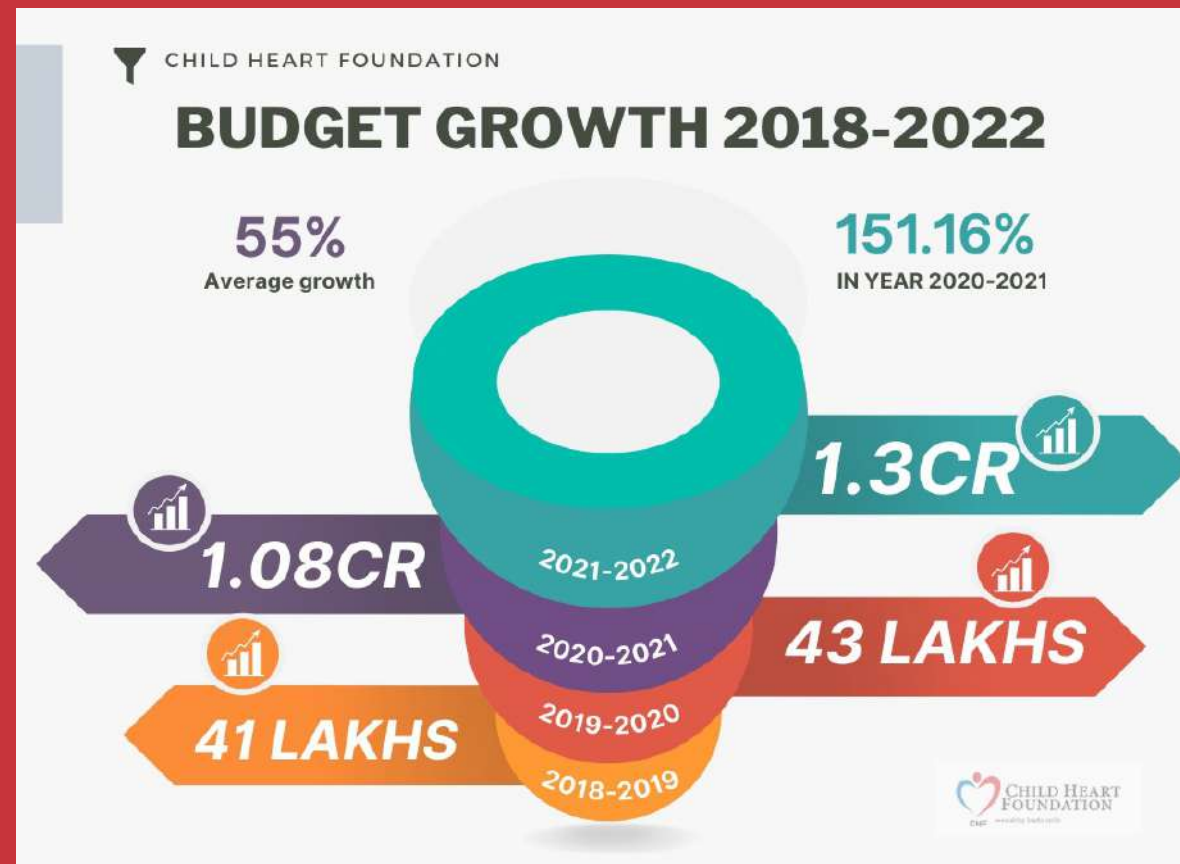

# STORIES OF POST SURGERIES



When Ashu first visited Child Heart Foundation, she was around seven to eight months pregnant. It was then that she discovered her child had a cardiac condition. She was scared and didn't know what to do at the time. A referral from Safdarjung Hospital brought her to Dr. Vikas sir, who founded Child Heart Foundation. He examined Maanik and informed her of the condition and that he would require surgery for him to survive. But she didn't have the necessary funds for the operation, nor did she have the courage to determine what to do and what not to do. She had given up hope and told Dr. Vikas sir, "she might not be able to give birth to this child since she didn't have the money needed to pay for the procedure," but Dr. Vikas sir gave her the hope and confidence she needed. He assured her that she wouldn't have to worry about money since Child Heart Foundation would cover her child's operation and that everything would be OK.

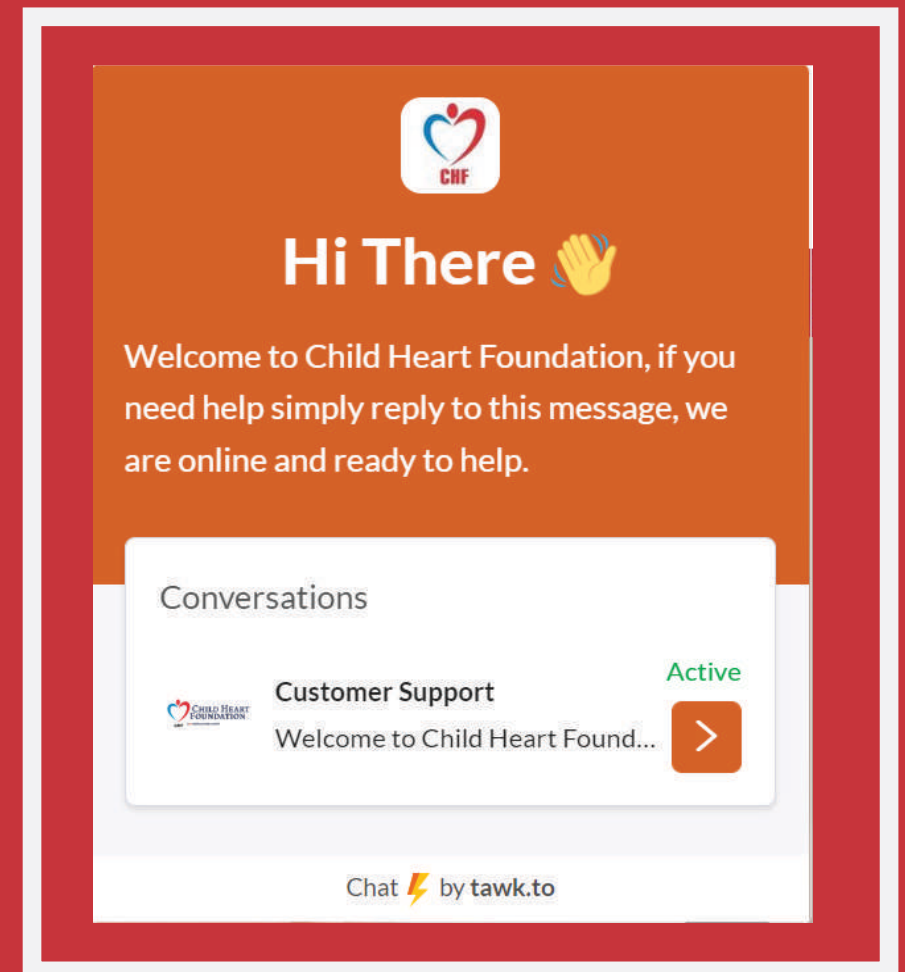

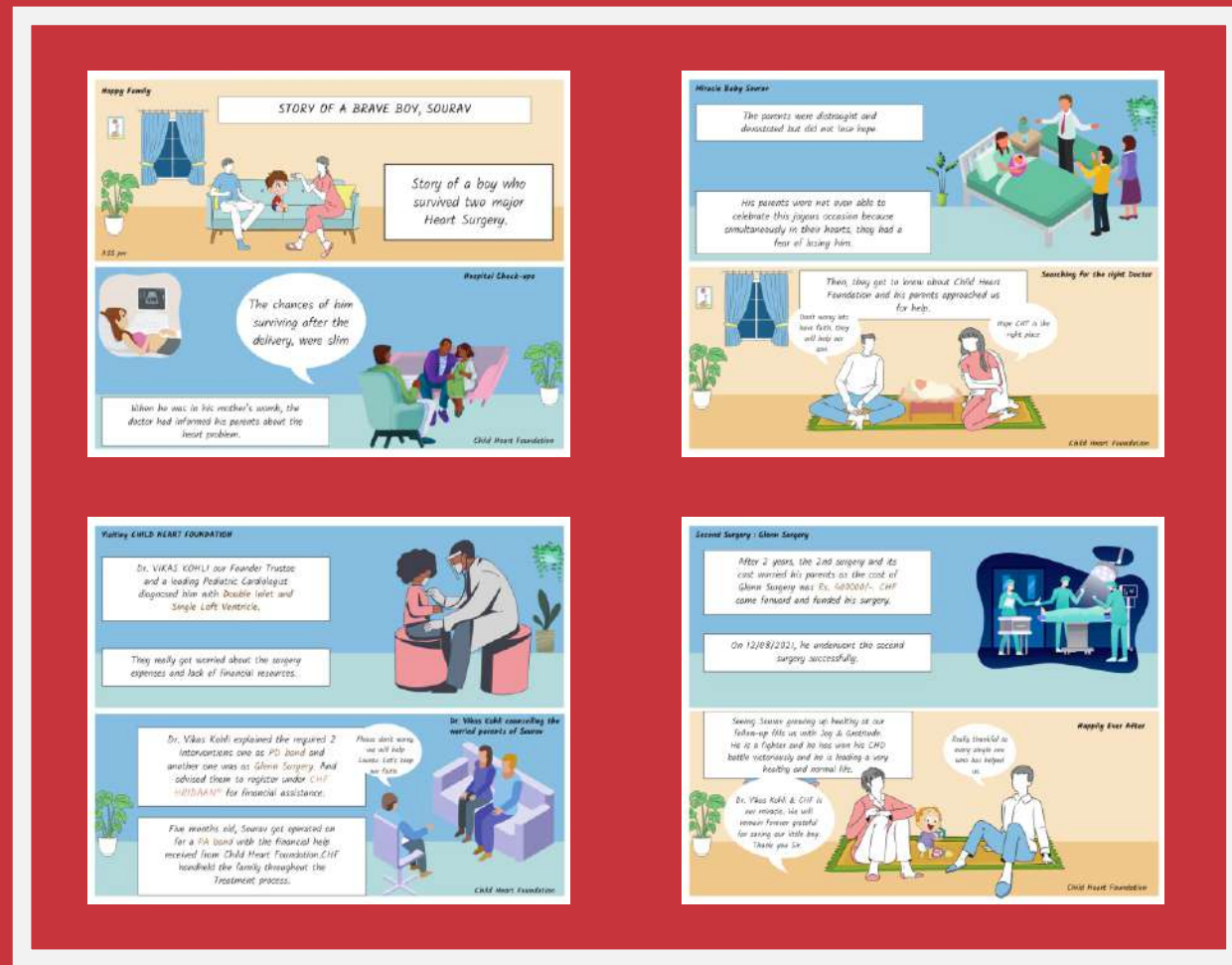

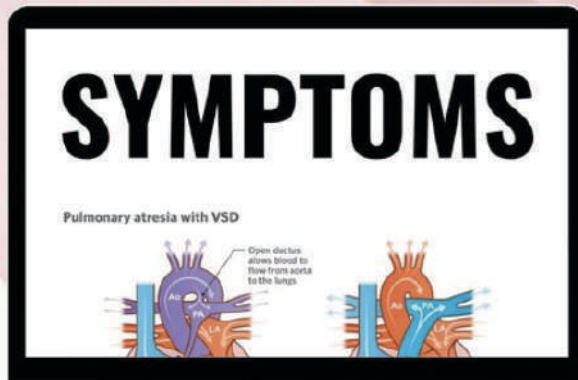

## ( SUCCESS STORY OF NABA )

Naba is four years old and has been diagnosed with a life-threatening disease called Complex Cyanotic. The parents are worried as her condition is critical and the symptoms are only getting aggravated with time.

The doctors had already informed Naba's parents during the fetal echo that she would have a CHD. The symptoms persisted after her birth and with time, have only gotten worse. She cannot play or run freely as she immediately gets breathing problems. Her nails turn blue, and she has also fainted a couple of times.

Naba's family got to know about Child Heart Foundation through another doctor. When they finally visited the centre, Dr. Vikas Kohli counselled the family and shared the diagnosis. She needs Cath & Glenn, and the estimated cost is Rs. 4,00,000.

On 8th April, 2022, Naba got her GLENN surgery done successfully and she was discharged. She has come for follow-up and after a thorough examination by Dr. Vikas Kohli, it's safe and joy to say that Nana is healing and getting back to normal.

Naba's father couldn't hide his joy and thank us profoundly especially Dr. Vikas Kohli for handling holding during and even after the surgery.
