तीन साल की जंग के बाद धड़का अभिषेक का दिल

बौद्ध (झरुई)। जन्मजात हृदय रोग से जुड़े जलसूय बच्चे के सिकंदर गंग निवासी तीन वर्षीय अभिषेक को अतिरिक्त नई जिंदगी मिल गई। कठिन तीन वर्षों तक बीमारी से संघर्ष करने वाले अभिषेक का दिलवाले के इंटरम अस्पताल में सफल हृदय ऑपरेशन किया गया। यह संभव हो सका राष्ट्रीय खात स्वास्थ्य कार्यक्रम (आयुष्मान) के तहत, चार्लोट हार्ट फाउंडेशन और इंटरम गैस लिमिटेड (आईसीएल) के संयुक्त प्रयासों से। सिकंदर गंग निवासी प्रतीक का पुत्र अभिषेक जन्म से ही फेबल हृदय रोग से पीड़ित था। आर्थिक रूप से



सहायोग से उनके बेटे को नया जीवन मिला है, जिसके लिए वे सभी के आभारी हैं। चार्लोट हार्ट फाउंडेशन के सम्बन्धक टुलसी एवं बाल हृदय रोग विशेषज्ञ डॉ. विकास कोहली ने बताया कि जन्मजात हृदय रोग से पीड़ित बच्चों को समय पर पारखन और उपचार बिना जल्दी है। सही समय पर फैसला और आवश्यक सहायता मिलने पर अधिकतर बच्चों का सफल इलाज संभव है। उन्होंने कहा कि संस्थ का उद्देश्य आर्थिक रूप से कमजोर परिवारों के बच्चों को गुणवत्तापूर्ण हृदय उपचार उपलब्ध कराने है। अभिषेक को यह कठानी सकारात्मक स्वास्थ्य संकेतों, सामाजिक सम्बन्ध और कॉर्पोरेट सहायोग के सफल सम्मेलन की निशान बन गई है। समय पर पारखन, उचित इलाज और आर्थिक सहायता ने एक मायूस को जिंदगी बच ली और उसके परिवार को उम्मीदों की फिर से जीर्ण कर दिया।

कमजोर परिवार के लिए मरीज इलाज कराने संभव नहीं था। इसी दौरान आर्थिक संकटों के तहत जलसूय को नजर बचने पर चले। तब वे जंग के बाद इंटरम गैस लिमिटेड (आईसीएल) को उपचार के लिए चार्लोट हार्ट फाउंडेशन के पास चलाया। चार्लोट हार्ट फाउंडेशन ने बच्चों को

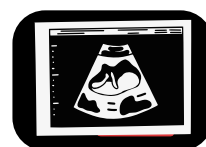

Early Diagnosis. Lifesaving Action. Together with Concentrix.



With the support of Concentrix, Child Heart Foundation held a Medical Camp in Gurgaon. On May 16, 2026
